THE PRAYERS OF CONFESSION

ALL: Father, we come to you in need of your mercy. Far too often, our actions betray the grace that you have shown to us. We have failed in many ways to love other people without reservation. We confess that our tendency is to favor those who can benefit our lives. We have often been indifferent to the troubles of our neighbors and have failed to join compassion with action. And even in the moments when we have done the right things, we have often performed these actions from self-righteous motivations. Jesus, we thank you that you did not act in this way toward us. Instead, you loved us with an everlasting love and showed us rich mercy and lavish grace. Lord God, please forgive us. Enable us to abide in your love and to demonstrate genuine faith through the things we do.
