9/6/17 (Dinner Night)	Q76: How many commandments did God give on Mount Sinai? <i>A: Ten commandments..</i> Q77: Why should we obey the Ten Commandments? <i>A; Because God is our Creator, Savior and King.</i>
9/13/17	Q78: What do the first four commandments teach? <i>A: What it means to love and serve God.</i>

11/1/17 (Dinner Night)	Q84: What is the first commandment? <i>A: The first commandment is "You shall have no other gods before Me.""</i> Q85: What does the first commandment teach you? <i>A: To worship the true God, and him only.</i>
11/8/17	Q86: What does the second commandment teach you? <i>A: The second commandment is "You shall not make for yourself a carved image—any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth; you shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me, but showing mercy to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments." (NKJV)</i> Q87: What does the second commandment teach you? <i>A: To worship God only as he commands, and not to worship God by using statues or pictures.</i>

1/10/18	<p>Q88: What is the third commandment? <i>A: The third commandment is "You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold him guiltless who takes His name in vain." (NKJV)</i></p> <p>Q89: What does the third commandment teach you? <i>A: To treat God's name, word and works with reverence.</i></p>
1/17/18	<p>Q90: What is the fourth commandment? <i>A: The fourth commandment is "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the LORD your God. In it you shall do no work: you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger who is within your gates. For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it." (NKJV)</i></p> <p>Q91: What does the fourth commandment teach you? <i>A: To work six days and keep the Sabbath day holy.</i></p>

1/31/18 (Dinner Night)	<p>Q92: What day of the week is the Christian Sabbath? <i>A: The first day of the week, called the Lord's Day.</i></p> <p>Q93: Why is it called the Lord's Day? <i>A: Because on that day the Lord Jesus Christ rose from the dead.</i></p> <p>Q94: How should you keep the Lord's Day? <i>A: I should rest from my daily work and faithfully worship God.</i></p>
2/7/18	<p>Q95: What is the fifth commandment? <i>A: The fifth commandment is "Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the Lord your God is giving you." (NKJV)</i></p> <p>Q96: What does the fifth commandment teach you? <i>A: To love and obey my parents and all others that God appoints over me</i></p>
2/14/18 (Dinner Night)	<p>Q97: What is the sixth commandment? <i>A: The sixth commandment is "You shall not murder." (NKJV)</i></p> <p>Q98: What does the sixth commandment teach you? <i>A: Not to take anyone's life unjustly and not to sin when I am angry.</i></p>

2/21/18	<p>Q99: What is the seventh commandment? <i>A: The seventh commandment is "You shall not commit adultery." (NKJV)</i></p> <p>Q100: What does the seventh commandment teach you? <i>A: To be pure in heart, language and conduct, and to be faithful in marriage</i></p>
2/28/18 (Dinner Night)	<p>Q101: What is the eighth commandment? <i>A: The eighth commandment is "You shall not steal." (NKJV)</i></p> <p>Q102: What does the eighth commandment teach you? <i>A: Not to take anything that belongs to someone else.</i></p>
3/7/18	<p>Q103: What is the ninth commandment? <i>A: The ninth commandment is "You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor." (NKJV)</i></p> <p>Q104: What does the ninth commandment teach you? <i>A: Never to lie, but to tell the truth at all times.</i></p>
3/14/18 (Dinner Night)	<p>Q105: What is the tenth commandment? <i>A: The tenth commandment is "You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, nor his male servant, nor his female servant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor anything that is your neighbor's." (NKJV)</i></p> <p>Q106: What does the tenth commandment teach you? <i>A: To be content with whatever God chooses to give me.</i></p>
