The Prayers of Confession

All: Father, we confess that we are often impatient and do not establish our hearts for your coming. In our sin and weakness, we find it difficult to trust you, to follow you, and to act kindly to one another. Too often, we dissect, criticize, despise, and plot against those we are called to love and build up in Christ. We lash out in anger, wounding others with our deeds and our words, rather than comforting with gentleness and kindness. We withdraw in bitterness, punishing others with our disdain and rejection, rather than drawing near to give mercy. We seek to control and manipulate, putting our own interest above the needs of others, rather than humbling ourselves and serving as Christ served us. Lord, be merciful to us and prepare us for your coming again. Establish our hearts in Christ Jesus that we may be a people after your own glory, basking in the abundance of your love, and living out the law of love toward those around us.

*The Profession of Faith: The Nicene Creed

ALL: We believe in one God, the Father Almighty,

Maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of His Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father; by whom all things were made; who for us and for our salvation came down from heaven, and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary, and was made man: and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate; He suffered and was buried; and the third day he rose again according to the Scripture, and ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father; and He shall come again, with glory, to judge both the living and the dead; whose kingdom shall have no end.
