THE SEASON OF ADVENT

For centuries the season of Advent has marked the beginning of the Christian year. "Advent" comes from the Latin advenire meaning coming or arrival, referring of course to the coming or arrival of Jesus. During Advent we celebrate two "arrivals" of Jesus: His first advent when He came in the flesh at Bethlehem; His second when He shall return in glory. Our celebration of Advent reminds us that God is faithful: He promised that the Christ would come and that in His coming He would conquer sin and death for all who would believe in Him—He has come. In addition, we are filled with great hope, for since Christ came as promised, we can trust that He is coming again as promised to bring to fruition all that was achieved through His first coming.

As has been the custom of the Church, we will light candles each Sunday to remind us of the advent(s) of Christ. There are many traditions as to what is symbolized by each candle. For some years we have followed a tradition that highlighted events in Jesus' first advent by lighting the Prophet Candle, the Angel Candle, the Shepherd Candle and the Bethlehem Candle. This year we are going to follow another tradition that highlights themes of Christ's advents with candles signifying Hope, Love, Joy and Peace.

The fifth candle in our advent wreath is the Christ Candle. We will light it at our worship service on the Eve of Christmas as we will read through the message of the gospel through nine passages of Scripture beginning with creation and culminating with the coming of Christ who is the light of the world.

This year we have the great blessing of Christmas Day falling on the Lord's Day. Gathering as we do each Sunday, we shall come together to cry "hallelujah," filled with gratitude that Christ has come, and filled with hope that Christ is coming again.
