

Resurrection Rolls



Ingredients

- One triangle of crescent roll dough per child
- 1 large marshmallow per child
- Melted butter
- Cinnamon sugar



1. Read John 19 while the oven is preheating to 350. Unroll the crescent rolls and place on a clean surface. Be sure your kiddos have washed their hands.



2. Give your child a marshmallow and explain that it represents Jesus, white and pure because He was without sin.



3. Roll the marshmallows in the melted butter. This symbolizes the embalming oils.



4. Roll the marshmallows in cinnamon sugar. This is like the spices used to prepare his body for burial.



5. Wrap the marshmallow in the crescent roll (cloth), pinching the dough together securely (some will probably leak anyway, but do your best). This represents how they wrapped Jesus' body. Place the rolls on a well-greased, rimmed baking sheet. Bake in the oven (the tomb) for 12 minutes.



6. While the rolls are baking, read John 20:1-18.



7. Open the tomb and remove the rolls. When they're cool enough to handle, break one open and discover what happened to the marshmallow.
